1-800 Committee Report

I apologize for my absence the last 2 meetings. I have arranged for the alternate GSR to attend in my place as my circumstances could not be changed. I look forward to attending the next meeting in June.

The following is an update on the happenings for the 800 Service.

-The phone bill from Verizon has been cleared up from last month. Verizon was overcharging for services cancelled months ago. They issued us a 61.00 credit which brings our current balance to a credit of 24.00 and some change.

-The phone committee has called several of the volunteers for the phone service and the 12 step calls and is continuing to call the remaining volunteers on the lists to assist them with the procedures to follow. Rich B was kind enough to acquire a copy of the AA Guidelines from GSO on proper procedures of the AA answering service and 12 step calls, which we are using to develop a packet for each volunteer. The volunteers will receive a call from the committee and a packet in the mail at which time they will be added to the phone service system to ensure all calls are handled appropriately and consistently.
